### **“North Carolina’s Black Patriots of the American Revolution”**

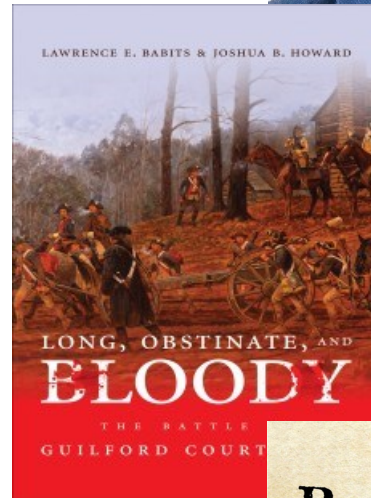

### **“The Forgotten Battle Within a Battle: The North Flank at Guilford Courthouse”**

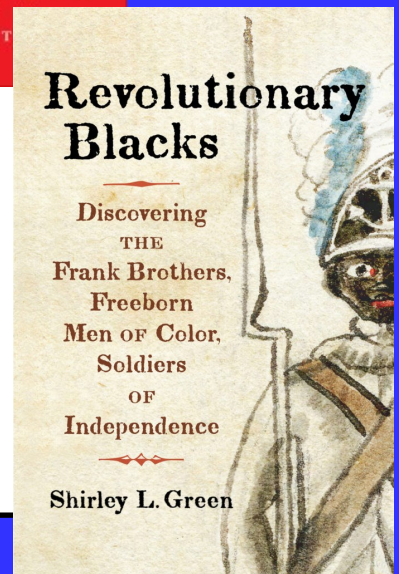
